Tsinghua's master's program in Global Environment Leadership (GELP) is an extension of the Global Environment Program (GEP) - a pioneering Bachelor program on global environment management in China. GELP prepares its students with "Global Competence" – the capability to learn, work and live with others from different cultures in order to embrace opportunities and challenges in the future.

GELP is dedicated to providing students with the tools, resources and the platform needed to thrive in international organizations. The program fosters a close connection between students and faculty members. Study and research programs are arranged individually by each student in consultation with two advisers from both Tsinghua and international organizations.

Upon successful completion of the program, students will be awarded a Master of Science in Environmental Science and Engineering by Tsinghua University.
